

European/Normandy Countryside



The Normandy countryside is dotted with farmland.

In the early summer the crops are still young, barely knee high, giving no cover.

All hedgerows on the table are Bocage hedgerows. These are taller than a tank, Very Difficult Going, and provide Bulletproof Cover to troops sheltering behind them. Teams must start adjacent to a Bocage hedgerow to cross it.

In early summer the stream is shallow, barely an obstacle, and counts as Difficult Going.

The country roads are so narrow that vehicles may neither pass nor turn on them.
