

Barkmann's Corner



The battle at Barkmann's Corner was fought in the heart of the Bocage Country. The dominant terrain is the Bocage hedgerows. Their six foot high banks are topped with hedgerows and trees creating an almost impassable obstacle to tanks.

Both the main road and the side roads are narrow roads. They are too narrow for two tanks to pass, or even to shoot past each other.

All hedgerows on the table are Bocage hedgerows. These are taller than a tank, Very Difficult Going, and provide Bulletproof Cover to troops sheltering behind them. Teams must start adjacent to a Bocage hedgerow to cross it.
